Household contacts require further investigation by either OPH or the school 	
PA Travel Mandate If you travel outside the state of PA (excluding work or attending school) for more than 24 hours, you must either quarantine for 10 days or a negative COVID-19 test must be provided to the nurse	return to school guidance for COVID-19 symptoms	 WITHOUT SYMPTOMS If unable to get a test or chooses not to test, individual must quarantine for 10 days upon arrival in PA If tested upon entering PA, or is waiting for results, the traveler must quarantine for 10 days, or until receipt of a negative test result
